The Oceanographic Institute will continue to provide its expertise to CFM Indosuez, particularly in the areas of the blue economy and key ocean-related challenges. This partnership will also offer exclusive benefits, including dedicated conferences and private tours of the Oceanographic Museum for clients, as well as opportunities for employees to take part in the Institute's projects during solidarity days.

A pioneer in sustainable finance in Monaco, CFM Indosuez launched the Principality's first fund dedicated to sustainable development in 2002. More recently, between 2021 and 2023, the bank strengthened its commitment by creating a range of solidarity-based structured products under the brand CFM Indosuez Oceano. These products, developed in collaboration with Crédit Agricole CIB, include a solidarity component: a donation made by clients, matched by contributions from CFM Indosuez and Crédit Agricole CIB. In total, €450,000 was raised over three years and donated to the Oceanographic Institute to support its Polar Mission program and its efforts to preserve the ocean and marine ecosystems.
